



Turn off electronics when not in use.




Close the fridge door to prevent cold air from escaping.

Close doors and windows when the AC or heat is on.




Unplug chargers when electronics are fully charged.

Put on a sweater if you're too cold or remove unneeded layers if you're too hot instead of adjusting the thermostat.




Don't block air vents with drapes or furniture.




Always think energy smart and try be aware of how much energy you're using.

Upgrade incandescent lightbulbs to more efficient ones like LED or CFL.




Make the switch!




Turn off lights when not in use.

68-72° for winter**




Turn off the bath fan after use.
