## Juniper Router Replacement RFP

## 1. Background

Johnson City Energy Authority (DBA: BrightRidge) is an Electric and Broadband provider that serves the Northeast Tennessee county of Washington County, and parts of Geene, Sullivan, and Carter Counties over an area of more than 350 sq miles. BR serves more than 82,000 electric customers and 22,000 broadband customers via a Calix FTTx network. BR began fiber services in 2019 and has Juniper Networks for its core network routing and switching, utilizing Calix E9 OLT and Calix ONT's for service delivery.

## 2. Introduction

BR is looking to replace its edge network (2) Juniper MX10003 routers due to end-of-life notices. We are looking to replace these with (2) MX304 routers with 2 LMIC's in each supporting 400G and multiple 4x100G interfaces. BrightRidge will do rack/stack and provide input to design and configurations. Vendor will provide a 'turnkey' configuration and work with BrightRidge Network Engineering during after-hours maintenance windows. Required hardware and design approach listed in RFP.

## 3. Project Scope

BR's current router implementation consists of (2) MX10003 routers and we are looking to replace these with (2)MX304, each with 2 LMIC's. The existing routers peer with multiple BGP uplinks to transit and IX providers in Atlanta, GA and Ashburn, VA as well as to downstream Calix E9-CLX's and customer BGP readvertisements with some static routes.

- a. Current Configurations consist of:
  - i. (2) MX10003 Routers that are BGP peered with each other for redundancy. This has worked well but we are open to other design considerations. These are at 2 different geographical site within our local footprint
  - ii. Routers are BGP peered to 2 transit providers in both Atlanta, GA and Ashburn, VA as well multiple peers through IX's and direct peering.
  - iii. Bridge domains for L2 traffic
  - iv. BR does not currently utilize any OSPF, MPLS or VPLS within its network.

#### b. Project should include:

- i. A review of current configurations
- ii. Recommendations and configurations including best practices for the overall project and all protocols used, including, but not limited to,

- interface configurations, spanning tree protections, Control plane DDOS protections, network security.
- iii. Recommendations for best practice and efficient configuration for traffic engineering (ie pushing traffic through different devices/peers based on traffic load using prepends or other methods).
- iv. There should be an emphasis on the configuration review with recommendations for most effective BGP configuration determining the most efficient use of BGP groups and communities.
- v. Recommendations and considerations for future L4S (Low Latency, Low Loss, Scalable Throughput) implementation should be incorporated into network planning.
- vi. BR will "rack and stack" and provide remote access via VPN. BR will be responsible for any physical connection moves during maintenance windows.
- vii. Vendor will be responsible for working directly with BR Engineering on configuration design and implementation and shall be available during maintenance windows to assist with any issues that arise. **BR engineering will have final authority over design considerations and implementations.**
- viii. BR and selected vendor will have a virtual meeting at a mutual agreed upon time within 2 weeks of RFP award to discuss project plan, timeline, and initial design plans.

#### 4. Deliverables

- a. Hardware as listed in RFP
- b. Existing configuration review with emphasis on security and BGP efficiency
- c. New "turn-key" configuration in collaboration with BR Engineering.
- d. Support during implementation and maintenance windows
- e. Engineering support for a period of 6 months after project completion for issues BR suspects is related to configurations or protocols implemented during this project.
- f. Bi-Weekly meetings with BR Engineering and Vendor implementation staff/PM during project period. These meetings may be delayed or postponed at BR discretion based on current project activities. BR may also request, at its discretion, weekly meetings during times of peak project activity.

g. Project shall be completed by August 31, 2026 and all invoices submitted by September 15, 2026 unless extended by BR Network Engineering Manager. Work not completed by August 31, 2026 may be assessed a \$500.00 per day penalty unless written approval is provided by BrightRidge.

## 5. Qualifications

- a. Engineering services must be supported by on staff JNCIE-SP and JNCIE-ENT certified personnel that has carried that certification level for at least 5 years and has worked directly with Service Providers for at least 5 years.
- b. Vendor engineering must have at least 5 year's experience configuring and troubleshooting FTTx OLT hardware (Calix preferred) with Juniper network equipment. This is in order to expedite issue resolution during migrations.
- c. The Vendor must demonstrate that all key personnel that work directly with BrightRidge on this project possess fluent and proficient verbal and written communication skills in the English language. This proficiency is required to ensure clear, unambiguous, and timely communication regarding technical specifications, project milestones, risk management, and collaboration with BrightRidge staff. Proposals that do not confirm this proficiency for key roles may be deemed non-responsive.
- d. Vendor must submit a list of at least 5 references that are service providers and that the vendor provided engineering design services and/or implementation of Juniper hardware in the last 5 years. The reference list shall include a brief description of work provided and equipment implemented. It will be at BrightRidge discretion which of these references to contact.

## 6. Bid selection process:

BrightRidge reserves the right to reject any and/or proposals or to accept the offer deemed to be in the utility's best interest. BrightRidge reserves the right to waive any or all requirements contained in this invitation at its sole discretion.
